

## **ELIGIBILITY**

### **ELIGIBILITY & PROGRAMME**

Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha (Deemed to be University), Tirupati is going to conduct entrance tests for admission into Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed), Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed), Vishishtacharya (M.Phil) & Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) programmes, as specified centre in different parts of the country. Eligible candidates can apply online with in time.

### **SSET (B.Ed) Eligibility**

1. **At least 50% marks** or equivalent grade either in Shastri/B.A with Sanskrit/Equivalent Degree or Acharya/MA Sanskrit) Equivalent Degree.
2. Those who are appearing for qualifying examination can also apply.
3. **Minimum age-20 years as on 01-10-2019.**

### **SAET (M.Ed) Eligibility**

1. **At least 50% marks** or equivalent grade (Both Theory and Practical) either in Shiksha Shastri/B.Ed (with Sanskrit Teaching), Shastri/B.A. (with Sanskrit) or Acharya/M.A.(Sanskrit)/Equivalent Degree.
2. Those who are appearing for qualifying examination can also apply.
3. **Minimum age-22 years as on 01-10-2019.**

## **VAET (M.Phil) Eligibility**

### **1. (A) Eligibility for Vishishtacharya (M.Phil) Entrance Test in Shastras:**

1. All those candidates who want to appear for Vishishtacharya Entrance Test should have passed Acharya/M.A. (Sanskrit) or an equivalent degree (Sanskrit) from Universities, duly recognized by University Grants Commission **obtaining at least 55% marks in aggregate.**
2. **For Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non Creamy layer)/Person with Disability (PwD) categories should have passed Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with a minimum of 50% of Marks.**
3. Foreign candidates who have passed Acharya/M.A. (Sanskrit)/ equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 55% or more marks in aggregate from any University outside India can also apply for the VAET through the Ministry of External Affairs or Ministry of Human Resource Development.Govt. of India.
4. For appearing in the test, such candidates also shall be considered eligible who have appeared for **Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) but their result is awaited**, Such candidates shall be required to submit their mark-sheets showing the prescribed percentage of marks required for the registration, before the admission.
5. Reservation policy of G.O.I. shall be followed (Scheduled Caste - 15%, Scheduled Tribes - 7.5%, OBC - 27%) and other reservations are as per GOI policy from time to time.
6. Competent Authorities for issuing the Certificates for Reserved Categories are:- District Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Tehsildar.

### **(B) Eligibility for Vishishtacharya (M.Phil) Entrance Test in Education :**

1. Those who wish to appear for Vishishtacharya in Education should have Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) **or Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 55% of Marks along with P.G. Degree in Education with 55% of Marks.**
2. **For Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non Creamy layer)/Person with Disability(PwD) categories, with minimum 50% marks in Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) or Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 50% of Marks along with P.G. Degree in Education with minimum 50% of Marks.**
3. Foreign candidates who have passed Acharya/M.A. (Sanskrit)/ equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 55% marks in the aggregate from any University outside India **along with P.G. Degree in Education with 55% of Marks** can also apply for the VAET through the Ministry of External Affairs or Ministry of Human Resource, Govt. of India.
4. For appearing in the test, such candidates also shall be considered eligible who have appeared for **Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) but their result is awaited or those who appeared for P.G. Degree in Education but their result is awaited, along with Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 55% of Marks.** Such candidates shall be required to submit their mark-sheets showing the prescribed percentage of marks required for the registration, before the admission.
5. Reservation policy of G.O.I. shall be followed (Scheduled Caste - 15%, Scheduled Tribes - 7.5%, OBC - 27%) and other reservations are as per GOI policy from time to time.
6. Competent Authorities for issuing the Certificates for Reserved Categories are:- District Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Tehsildar.

## VVET(Ph.D) Eligibility

### 1.(A) Eligibility for Vidyavaridhi Entrance Test in Shastras :

1. All those candidates who want to appear for Vidyavaridhi Entrance Test should have passed Acharya/M.A. (Sanskrit) or an equivalent degree (Sanskrit) from Universities, duly recognized by University Grants Commission **obtaining at least 55% marks in aggregate.**
2. **For Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non Creamy layer)/Person with Disability (PwD) categories should have passed Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with a minimum of 50% of Marks.**
3. Foreign candidates who have passed Acharya/M.A. (Sanskrit)/ equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 55% or more marks in aggregate from any University outside India can also apply for the VVET through the Ministry of External Affairs or Ministry of Human Resource Development.Govt. of India.
4. For appearing in the test, such candidates also shall be considered eligible who have appeared for **Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) but their result is awaited**, Such candidates shall be required to submit their mark-sheets showing the prescribed percentage of marks required for the registration, before the admission.
5. Those eligible candidates who have passed in Vishishtacharya (M.Phil), cleared JRF/NET/SLET and awarded with National Fellowship (NF) are exempted from the Vidyavaridhi Entrance Test, but they must apply online application by paying the prescribed fee through online.
6. Reservation policy of G.O.I. shall be followed (Scheduled Caste - 15%, Scheduled Tribes - 7.5%, OBC - 27%) and other reservations are as per GOI policy from time to time.
7. Competent Authorities for issuing the Certificates for Reserved Categories are:- District Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Tehsildar.

### (B) Eligibility for Vidyavaridhi Entrance Test in Education:

1. Those who wish to appear for Vidyavaridhi in Education should have Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) **or Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 55% of Marks along with P.G. Degree in Education with 55% of Marks.**
2. **For Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non Creamy layer)/Person with Disability(PwD) categories, with minimum 50% marks in Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) or Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 50% of Marks along with P.G. Degree in Education with minimum 50% of Marks.**
3. Foreign candidates who have passed Acharya/M.A. (Sanskrit)/ equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 55% marks in the aggregate from any University outside India **along with P.G. Degree in Education with 55% of Marks** can also apply for the VVET through the Ministry of External Affairs or Ministry of Human Resource, Govt. of India.

4. For appearing in the test, such candidates also shall be considered eligible who have appeared for **Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.)** but their result is awaited **or those who appeared for P.G. Degree in Education but their result is awaited, along with Acharya/M.A(Sanskrit)/equivalent degree (Sanskrit) with 55% of Marks.** Such candidates shall be required to submit their mark-sheets showing the prescribed percentage of marks required for the registration, before the admission.
5. Those eligible candidates who have passed in Vishishtacharya (M.Phil), cleared JRF/NET/SLET and awarded with National Fellowship (NF) are exempted from the Vidyavaridhi Entrance Test, but they must apply online application by paying the prescribed fee through online.
6. Reservation policy of G.O.I. shall be followed (Scheduled Caste - 15%, Scheduled Tribes - 7.5%, OBC - 27%) and other reservations are as per GOI policy from time to time.
7. Competent Authorities for issuing the Certificates for Reserved Categories are:- District Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Tehsildar.
