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1. Brief Introduction of Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha:

Located at the feet of Tirumala mountain in Andhra Pradesh, the Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha was established at Tirupati in 1961 by the Govt. of India on the recommendations of the Sanskrit commission (1957) for the study of traditional Sanskrit literature through modern research methodology. In April 1971, this institution was given the status of autonomous body by the Ministry of Education under the protection of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan. In 1987 the Vidyapeetha was declared as Deemed to be University by the Govt. of India as per U.G.C. act 1956. Here teaching facilities are available for the study of following programmes viz., Prak-shastri, Shastri, B.A. (Hons.), B.Sc (Computer Science), B.Sc (Yoga), Acharya, M.A. in Hindi, M.A. (Shabdabodha), M.Sc (Yoga), MAIMT, Vishishtacharya (M.Phil), Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D), Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed.), Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) etc. The programmes of this organisation are duly recognized by NCTE and U.G.C. This Institution is a member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU). This Institution is assessed and accredited with 'A' grade (2nd cycle) by NAAC in 2015.

2. (I) Eligibility for Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed) admission:

- i. This programme is of Two years. Those students who have passed Shastri/B.A. (Skt.)/equivalent degree or Acharya/ M.A.(Skt.)/equivalent degree and Shiksha Shastri/B.Ed.(With Sanskrit Teaching) with 50% of marks from any recognized University are eligible. For candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Caste (OBC)/ Person with disability (PwD) categories, 5% relaxation will be allowed in the minimum pass percentage required for admission.
- ii. At least 50% marks in both theory and practical papers separately and 50% marks in the aggregate are required in Shiksha Shastri./B.Ed.(With Sanskrit Teaching).
- iii. For candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/ Person with disability (PwD) categories, 5% relaxation will be allowed in the minimum pass percentage required for admission 45% in each section (Theory & Practical) and 45% in aggregate.
- iv. The proof of having passed the qualifying examination should be submitted at the time of admission. In case the result is awaited, it must be submitted (declared or confidential) at the time of admission; otherwise the candidature of the applicant shall stand cancelled.

(II) Age-limit

A candidate seeking admission to Shiksha Acharya programme must have completed 22 years of age on or before 1st October, 2020. No age relaxation will be permitted.

(III) Method of Selection

Admission to Shiksha Acharya programme will be through merit. All candidates seeking admission to the programme must apply online. Merit-lists for admission will be prepared and the information for eligible candidates will be uploaded on website.

3. Admissions Procedure:

The admission into Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) programme in Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati will be on basis of merit. The merit will be based on the marks scored in Shiksha Sastri (B.Ed) / B.Ed (with Sanskrit Methodology) examinations. The medium of instruction and examination will be Sanskrit only. The number of seats available in Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha is given below:

4. Shiksha Acharya Programme Fees:

Tuition Fee:

Education is free, but for other expenditure a candidate will have to pay fees at the time of admission as per rules of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati.

Other expenditures:

For whatever miscellaneous expenditures is to be done on matters related to training activities have to borne by the student.

Hostel with mess facilities:

Hostel with mess facilities are available for eligible students. Apart from programme admission fee, hostel and mess fees are separate.

PUBLIC NOTICE WITH REFERENCE TO JAMMU

THE FOLLOWING CLARIFICATIONS WITH REGARD TO THE VALIDITY OF DEGREES OBTAINED FROM THE STATE OF J&K IN TEACHER EDUCATION ARE GIVEN FOR INFORMATION OF GENERAL PUBLIC AND ALL CONCERNED.

(i) Persons who have obtained Degrees/Diplomas/Certificates from Universities/Institutions recognized by the Govt. of J&K/UGC would be eligible for employment in Central Govt. & other States.

(ii) As the NCTE Act does not cover the issue of admission in institutions for higher qualifications, the eligibility of persons with degrees from institutions in J & K will not be governed by the provision of the NCTE Act but by the relevant laws/rules/regulations of the Respective States/Universities.

This has already been conveyed to all Education Secretaries of the States/ Universities vide NCTE letter no. 49-21-2005/NCTE/N&S Dated 31.5.2007 Ht. Dated 22.8.2007

6. Reservation of seats is as follows:

Out of the total number of seats in Shiksha Acharya, reservation as per rules of the Government of India will be applicable from time to time:

- For candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) 15%
- For candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe (ST) 7.5%
- For Other Backward Classes (OBC) Non-creamy layer as per Central Govt. List 27%
- **Note:** In case of non-availability of OBC candidates the seats will be filled up from the General Category candidates.
- For candidate belonging to Economically Weaker Section (EWS) 10%
- For Person with Disability (PwD) 3%
- For children/widows of Armed Forces Personnel disabled/killed during the war/Hostilities 3%
(Clear mentioning of disability/Death is essential in the certificate)
- For sportsmen (For participating at National/International level competitions only) 2%

Candidate who belongs to any of the above reserved categories should bring a certificate of their category duly attested by a Gazetted Officer at the time of admission in Vidyapeetha. Failing which the eligibility will be rejected. In case of non-availability of such candidates, the seats will be filled from the general category.

7. Competent Authorities for issuing the Certificates for Reserved Categories are as under:-

- i. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS Category- District Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Tehsildar/Competent Authority.
- ii. PwD and blind. Chief Medical Officer of Civil Hospital (**Only 40% or more disability will be considered.**)
- iii. For Children/Widows of Armed Forces personnel disabled/killed in the war/hostilities Secretary - Army/Navy/Air-force Board.

9. Most Important:

1. Read guidelines carefully.
2. These guidelines contain important information related to the admission.
3. Fill the online application carefully.
4. The facts mentioned in the online application will be duly verified at the time of admission.
5. On verification, if any type of false information is found legal action as per rules will be taken. It also includes disqualification from admission.
6. Upload your clear and latest photo on the online form. If the photo does not match properly at the time of admission then it may result in disqualification from the admission or any other legal action deemed fit.
7. **Candidate has to retain his/her mobile number given in online application till the completion of the admission process.** This is very important because all the informations about the admission will be sent through SMS to the given mobile number only.

10. Instructions for filling the online application:

The applicants can fill prescribed online application from websites of Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati only. The online applications filled after the last date will not be accepted. Only eligible candidates will be admitted in order of merit. This merit list will be valid for the academic year 2020-2021 only.

At the time of Admission in Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati to **Shiksha Acharya Programme the printed application form has to be submitted compulsorily.**

* **Please upload passport-size dated latest Photograph with date on the online application.**

* The students who have passed Shiksha Shastri **OR** appearing Shiksha Shastri II year final exam also eligible to apply.

11. Notable Points before Online Applying:

1. Only eligible candidates can apply for admission into the Shiksha Acharya programme. Non-eligible candidates for applying online application will themselves be responsible for the consequences.
2. **Shiksha Acharya programme is recognized by NCTE. The admission will be strictly on the basis of number of seats and merit.**
3. Scrutiny of eligibility for admission, verification of reservations etc. is under the control of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati.
4. In case of admission, the decision of the Vice-Chancellor of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati shall be final.
5. All legal matters will be settled under **Amaravati** (Andhra Pradesh) HIGH COURT JURISDICTION only.
